


Color Scavenger Hunt

What You Need:

• 2 Color Scavenger Hunt Printouts

What You Do:

- 1. Use the printouts to match colors in your house/yard to the colors on the sheet. See how many items you can find!
- 2. Go explore and have fun!



Rainbow Walking

What You Need:

- 3 Mason Jars
- 10 Paper Towels
- 1 bottle of yellow food coloring
- 1 bottle of red food coloring


What You Do:

- 1. Place the three mason jars in a straight line from left to right.
- 2. Fill up the two jars on the ends with water. Leave the middle jar empty. Your jars should line up like this:

#1 Water filled Jar #2 Empty Jar #3 Water Filled Jar

- 3. Put two drops of yellow food coloring in jar #1 (the jar on the left) and stir with a spoon.
- 4. Put two drops of red coloring in jar #3 (the jar on the right) and stir.
- 5. You should now have two jars with water and food coloring, and one empty jar in the middle.
- 6. Get 2 paper towel sheets and fold each sheet landscape (hotdog style).
- 7. Take each folded sheet and fold it in half again hotdog style.
- 8. Take one folded paper towel sheet and place one end of the sheet in the jar#1, and the other end of the folded sheet in the jar #2.
- 9. Repeat step 8 with the other folder paper towel and place one end in jar #3 and jar #2.
- 10.Now wait and see what happens!

Lava Lamp

What You Need:

- 1 empty Mason Jar
- 1 mason jar filled with oil
- 1 bottle of food coloring of your choice
- 1 Alka Seltzer
- 1 Plastic tablecloth

What You Do:

- 1. Lay out the tablecloth on your surface, so you don't make a mess.
- 2. Fill the empty mason jar about $\frac{1}{3}$ of water.
- 3. Put three drops of food coloring (you pick the color) into the jar with the water, then stir!
- 4. Fill the rest of the jar with oil to the top. Make sure not to fill it up too much!
- 5. Take the Alka Seltzer tablet and divide it into 4 pieces
- 6. Take one of those pieces and place it into your jar. You only need the one piece so you can throw away the other 3 pieces.
- 7. Now watch what happens!
